

Seekonk Speedway Trailer races

Tow some fun around Seekonk in 2012

This race is held with teams using one vehicle hooked to a trailer and another used as the defender. As teams circle the track the object will be for the trailers to complete a selected number of laps still hooked up to the tow vehicle. The defender car on each team is used to try and knock the opponent's trailers loose and defend their own team's trailer.

Any time a trailer becomes separated from the vehicle on the track that vehicle WILL BE BLACK FLAGGED and unable to complete the remainder of that race.

Vehicles eligible for use must follow the same rules as Enduro/Figure 8 cars.

No full size trucks can be used in the trailer races for safety proposes.

Trailers:

Minimum trailer length -16' maximum -24'. Measurement is from tongue to trailing edge of trailer. Two or four wheel axles permitted.

Trailers can be campers, boats (Only steel or fiberglass with a FLAT nose) No pointed bows or open deck trailers permitted.

Jack posts must swivel to horizontal position or be removed.

Open trailers need to have something in them that promote fun for all.

Each trailer will be judged for its starting spot. The more excitement each trailer brings to the fans, helps the teams earn their starting spots up front. Create a theme that makes your team a winner.

Trailer must finish still attached to vehicle by trailer hitch and have one axle still in place.

Trailer hitch VERY IMPORTANT standard type hitches 2-5/16" mimum ball size.

Double Safety Chains are MANDTORY.
